Tournament Setup and Rules

4—Person Teams, SCRAMBLE format.

Registration begins 3 PM. Golfers will receive a “goodie bag”, glow stick and necklace, raffle ticket, and 1 LED golf ball.

Daylight Shotgun start 5 PM. Golfers will ONLY use holes 5-13, Normal Tees.

Intermission: Sandwich and a side to be provided by “The Shed”. JCK9 will conduct demonstrations on K9 abilities and team equipment. Cash bar available.

Nighttime Shotgun start 8 PM. Golfers return to starting hole and play holes 5-13 again from the **RED TEES ONLY** (LED markers to identify the tee box). Golfers select the color ball they want from the 7 color changing ball provided.

Hayden Freeman (Long Drive Tour Player) will be on hand from Charities Golf International to help us with the daytime Par 5. Would you like to use his drive and a chance for a Double Eagle and potentially a trip to Pebble Beach?

Long Drive Contest (Night). Using hole #1, golfers will have 3 opportunities to hit designated LED balls (\$20), distances will be verified by JCK9 personnel using our Garmin GPS collars. A ledger will be maintained at the tee to document each persons LONGEST drive. Trophy to winning drive.

Closest to the Pin (Night). Hole #5 during the night portion of the event. A LED marker will be placed at the location of the current ball closest to the pin by JCK9 personnel. Trophy for closest to the pin.

Mulligans. \$25 Mulligan Package will consist of 2 mulligans per round (Additional LED Ball included in this package). A yard of string to be used on the greens to cut for distances to make the putt with no additional stroke. Scissors will be provided on each flag stick to cut the string.

DIRTY GOLF. Tired of competing against “STACKED” teams, here’s your opportunity get your revenge. \$10 donation can add a 1 stroke penalty to the team of your choice. For the team receiving the penalty, it will take \$20 to have the 1 stroke penalty removed. (All in good fun to benefit our cause).
